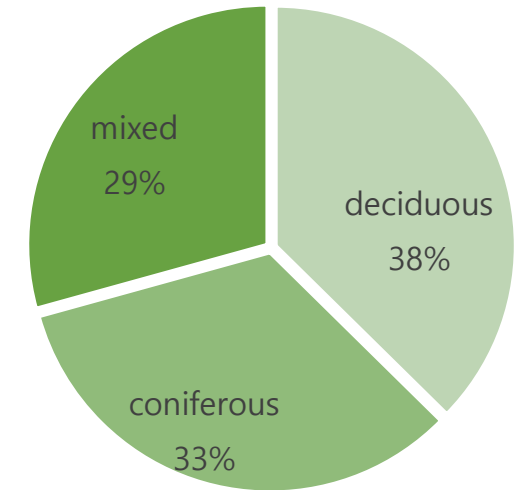
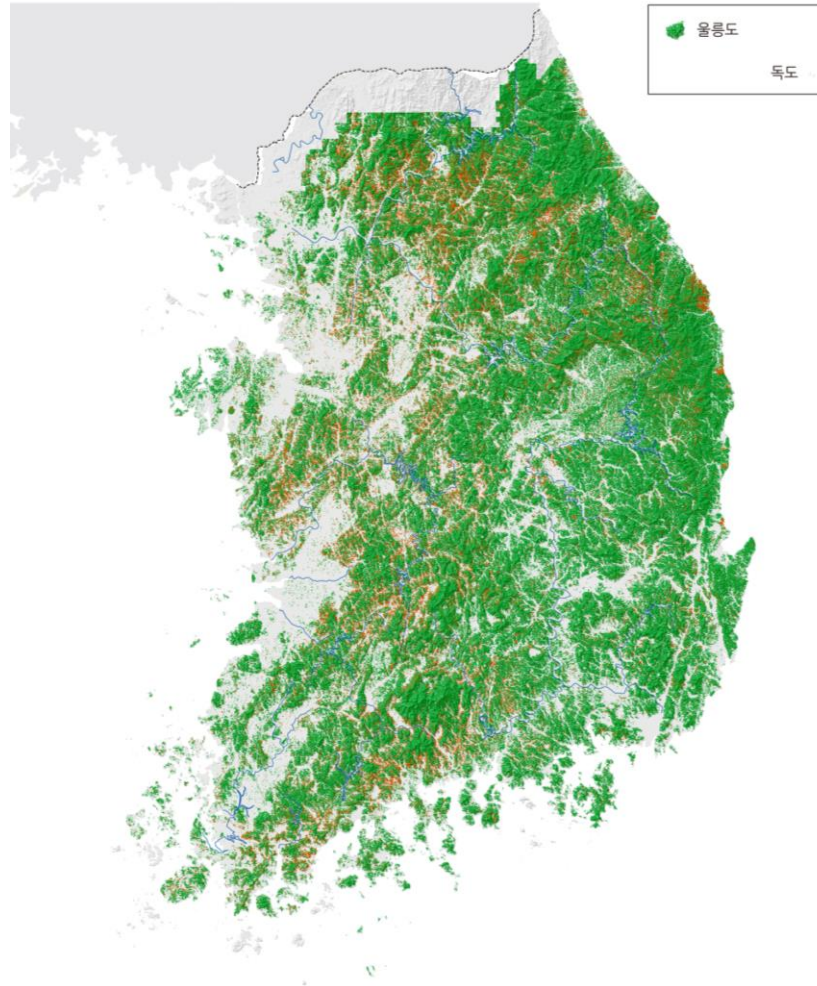
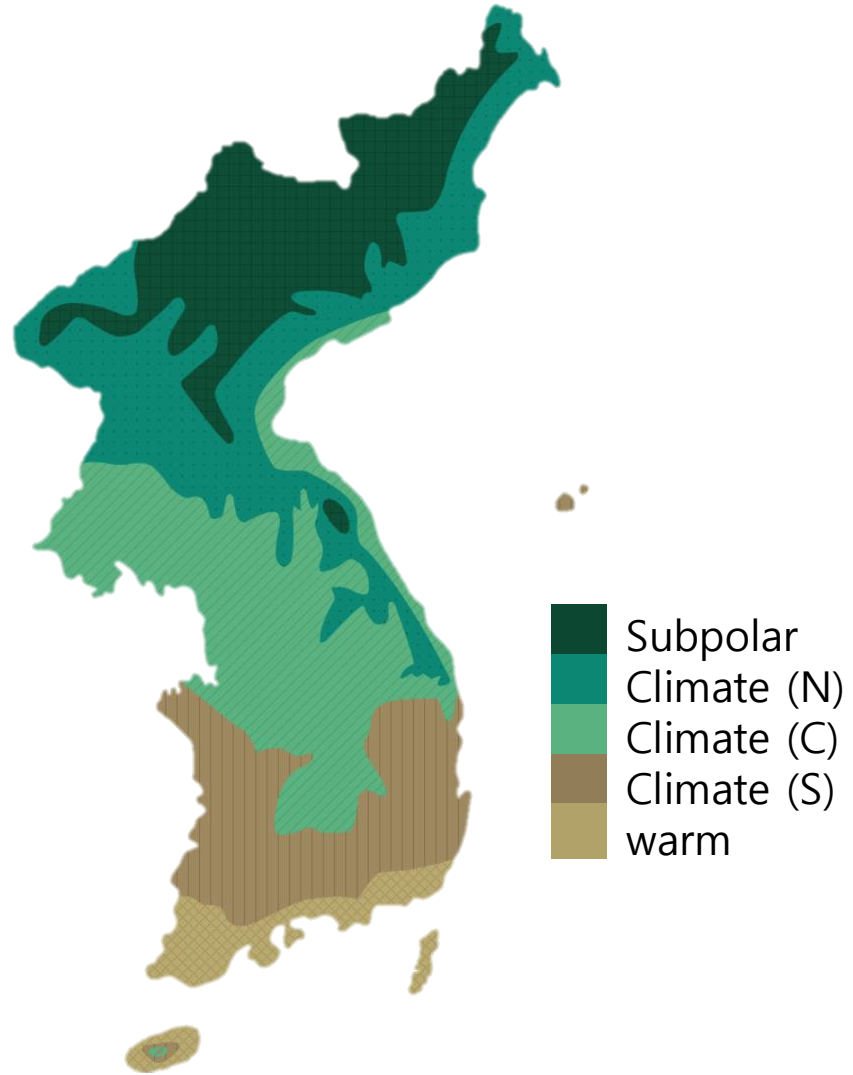
Seoul, the capital, has modernity with ancient historical sites, reflecting Korea's rich heritage.

“The only divided nation”

Forests blooming on the land divided by division.

Established after the armistice agreement of the Korean War in 1953, the DMZ was created to prevent military conflicts between the two Koreas. The dmz is recognized as a conservation area aimed at preserving natural ecosystems free from human interference, housing rare wildlife, and diverse plant species.

The sole successful afforestation nation.

Korea's afforestation efforts have seen significant progress over the past few decades. Following the devastation of the Korean War in the 1950s, Korea's forests suffered immense damage.

Korea's afforestation success is not solely attributed to **government policies** but also owes much to the dedication and **efforts of its citizens.**

Community-based afforestation initiatives have played a vital role in complementing government-led programs. Schools, civic groups, and individuals have organized tree-planting events, clean-up campaigns, and educational programs to promote environmental stewardship.

Climate change is having adverse effects on forest ecosystems.

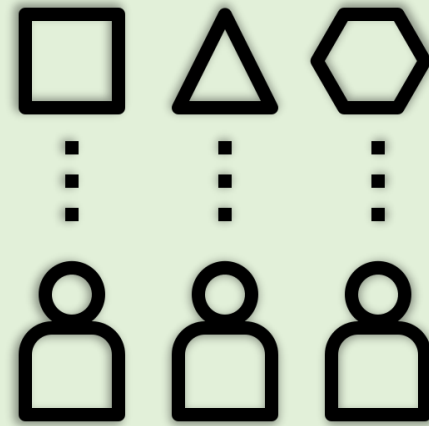
Forestry settlement faces challenges such as land scarcity for cultivation, a lack of sustainable forest management models, and the absence of relevant policies.
