OUR COUNTRY

Nigeria, officially the Federal Republic of Nigeria, is a country in West Africa. It is situated between the Sahel to the north and the Gulf of Guinea to the south in the Atlantic Ocean. It covers an area of 923,769 square kilometres (356,669 sq mi). With a population of more than 230 million, it is the most populous country in Africa, and the world's sixth-most populous country. Nigeria borders Niger in the north, Chad in the northeast, Cameroon in the east, and Benin in the west. Nigeria is a federal republic comprising 36 states and the Federal Capital Territory, where the capital, Abuja, is located. The largest city in Nigeria is Lagos, one of the largest metropolitan areas in the world and the largest in Africa.

BACKGROUND

The current state of Nigerian forests is a topic of concern. Nigerian forest cover is diminishing in extent and quality. Deforestation rates are increasing at an estimated loss of over 50% of original forest cover, illegal logging, and encroachment continue to pose significant threats to our valuable ecosystems. These incredibly diverse forests inhabiting over 4,000 different plant species also support a wide range of wildlife including the endangered species like the Nigeria-Cameroon chimpanzee and the Cross River gorilla.

Research shows that from 2011-2020, Nigeria loses a whooping 13% of its total forest cover.





This represent the birds species of Nigeria (Avifauna), Nigeria is said to have a total of 975 birds species, one of the highest in the world.






This borderline represent the map of Nigeria, with a total size of 923,768 sq km.
